





DISCIPLINE

A special emphasis is laid on Self - discipline as a part of college life. Upright behaviour, politeness, courteous attitude and respect for elders is constantly insisted upon. The college feels that any education is incomplete without discipline and hence discipline is expected from the students at all times. The management gives due weightage to discipline while granting admission in the college.

GENERAL BEHAVIOURAL RULES

In order to establish a healthy educational atmosphere and to achieve a disciplined way of life, all students must strictly follow the rules given below:

- 1. A studious atmosphere must prevail in the class rooms as well as in the premises of the college.
- Students will respect the teachers / the staff and they will show respect to the authorities concerned when they visit other colleges / institutions for competitions and other activities etc. and they will refrain from any action that disturbs order.
- Unnecessary roaming about, wasting time, making unwanted comments or causing chaos in the college
 premises must be avoided at any cost.
- 4. Tobacco, Pan and other drugs are totally banned in the premises and the persons who are resorting to such practices will be penalized or will face immediate dismissal depending on the degree of misconduct.

- 5. No student, without the authorisation of the Principal, claim to represent the college at any organisation of students or at any political or civic organisations what so ever.
- All students will treat the College Property with care and consideration. They will not make any marks
 on the furniture or the walls Any damage or destruction of the College property will be punishable
 individually and collectively.
- It is compulsory for the students to wear an Identity card of the college around the neck. Fine will be levied on the defaulter student.
- 8. Visitors are not allowed to meet the students directly in the class rooms. The visitors will contact the college office and the college office will arrange for the meeting.
- Students who have got legitimate grievances can present them to the Principal personally. Any other
 modes of protest must be strictly avoided.
- 10. Students who are guilty of serious misconduct or whose presence in the College is detrimental to the order and discipline in the premises are liable to be expelled.
- 11. Bringing and using mobile phones inside the college campus is strictly prohibited. The defaulters' mobile with Sim card will be confiscated & will be returned only after personal visit & written apology of parents.

Candidates seeking admission to various courses in this college must give an undertaking, counter signed by their parent/guardian, before the principal stating that they will leave the college voluntarily in case of violation of any of the above rules and regulations.

ATTENDANCE

Regular attendance is an important element for the successful working of the college. Hence nobody should remain absent from the class. 75% attendance is compulsory in each term to appear for the semester / University examination. A prolonged absence without approval may result into dismissal from the college.

- Regular attendance is a must in this college. Candidates seeking admission to various courses must abide by this rule and any violation of this rule will invite stern action.
- 2. The record of presence will be taken at the beginning of each period.
- Absence even for one period or late reporting for the lectures will be considered as absence for the whole day.
- 4. Students who are absent for the first week of the term shall be considered to have left the college, unless they have the permission from the Principal to do so.
- 5. Students may take leave only for illness and other genuine reasons after submitting leave application in writing to the Principal with necessary supporting documents..
- 6. Students who are irregular will have to explain the reason for their irregularity to the principal and if found unsatisfactory, they will have to leave the college in the following term.

- 7. Permission to appear for the University Examination will be granted to the students only as per the University rule
- 8. ADMISSION TO THE SECOND TERM WILL NOT BE GRANTED TO THOSE STUDENTS WHO DO NOT HAVE MINIMUM REQUIRED ATTENDANCE DURING THE FIRST TERM.
- The grace of class room attendance in case of those who are pursuing Professional Courses like CA,
 CS etc. will be considered by the Board of Trustees/Management Committee as and when required.

FOR PARENTS AND GUARDIANS

From the perusal of the general regulations, parents and guardians must note that those who are admitted to this college are expected to maintain a fairly high standard of diligence and good conduct. It is presumed that the parents and guardians of students admitted in this college accept all regulations of the college. Parents and guardians are recommended to call on the Principal at least once a term, to ascertain from her about the conduct and progress of their wards.

RULES OF AMENDMENT

The Principal or Management has the right to introduce, amend or change the rules and regulations in furtherance of the aims, objectives and ideals of the managing trust and the college when the necessity arises.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE - FOR B. COM. SEM-I AND B. B. A. SEM-I COURSES

- Prospective candidates are required to fill in the college application form, which can be collected personally from the college on or before the last date prescribed in the admission notice in the local newspapers.
- 2. Before filling the application form, the Candidates are advised to carefully go through the prospectus and application form for the details of admission process, basis of selection etc.

- 3. Candidates from Boards other than that of Gujarat and Candidates from other Universities will have to attach the Provisional Eligibility Certificate, which can be obtained from Saurashtra University, Rajkot. (Candidates seeking P.E.C. will have to go to the Academic Department Saurashtra University, Kalavad Road, Rajkot with Original and photo copies of (i) S. S. C. Mark sheet (ii) H. S. C. Mark sheet (iii) School Leaving Certificate (iv) Migration Certificate.)
- A candidate seeking admission should submit the photo copies of the following certificates along with the application form, as applicable

1. S. S. C. Mark sheet

2. H. S. C. Mark sheet

3. School Leaving Certificate

4. First Attempt Certificate

5. Provisional Eligibility Certificate (only for the candidates from Boards other than Gujarat Board.)

- The merit list of eligible candidates will be displayed on the notice board of the college. Displaying the names in
 the merit-list does not guarantee admission to the specified course. Admission to a course is based upon personal
 counseling.
- 6. Eligible candidates will have to come for a personal interview with either of their parents on the date and time specified in the merit list. Candidates not coming for the counseling as per the schedule will lose their claim for the admission.
- 7. Candidates, who are granted admission will have to pay the fees in Nawanagar Bank, Haria school Extension Counter within the given time limit. In case of cancellation of admission within one month from the date of remittance of fee, 50% of the fee will be refunded. Fees will be not refunded if the admission is cancelled after one month. Absence with or without leave from the college shall not be an excuse for non payment of fees on the prescribed date. Fee Card should be preserved for future reference.
- 8. Caution deposit will be refunded to the students completing three years of study during the month of August of the next academic year on presenting the receipt of caution money. For those who discontinue their study and leave the college, caution deposit will be refunded within one month of issue of "No Objection Certificate".
- 9. The right of granting admission is exclusively reserved by the Management and the Admission committee.

CRITERIA FOR GRANTING ADMISSION

Admission will be granted on First Come First Served basis for the students from English Medium Schools with 60% marks and above and for the students from Gujarati Medium Schools with 70% marks and above with a minimum of 60 marks in English Subject. For the students with marks lesser than that stated above,

admission will be granted on merit based Rank Mark System in which percentage weightage will be given to students on the ground of students from the school maneged by parent trust, English as a medium of instruction at school level, National level participation in sports, NCC, NSS etc. The percentage weightage to be given to the above will be decided by the management from time to time.

ELIGIBILITY

1. For Admission to B.Com. Sem I:-

The candidate should have passed H. S. C. examination in general stream or any equivalent examination recognised by Saurashtra University with at least 50% marks for English Medium students and 60% marks for Gujarati Medium Students.

2. For admission to B.Com. Sem III/B. Com Sem V:-

The candidate should have passed B.Com. Sem I and II / B.Com. Sem III and IV examinations respectively with at least 50% marks (aggregate) with Accounting & Finance or Business Management as an elective subject from Saurashtra University or any other university recognised by Saurashtra University. Applicants may be required to clear an English Proficiency Test conducted by the college.

3. For admission to B.B.A Sem I.:-

The candidate should have passed H. S. C. Examination or its equivalent examination from any stream at the first attempt with at least 50% marks in aggregate with English as his / her compulsory subject.

4. For admission to B.B.A. Sem III / B.B.A. Sem V:-

The candidate should have passed B.B.A. Sem I and II / B.B.A. Sem III and IV examinations respectively with at least 55% marks (aggregate) from Saurashtra University or any other university recognised by Saurashtra University. Applicants may be required to clear an English Proficiency Test conducted by the college.

IMPORTANT

- 1. The candidate should have passed the qualifying examination in First attempt.
- The candidate shall have to apply for the above course within the two years of the clearance of the qualifying examination. In case of any gap the candidate shall be required to submit a Gap Certificate/ affidavit.
- 3. Admission to the course is finalized when:
 - The candidate has successfully faced the personal counseling
 - All documents given are in order
 - Fees are paid
- 4. All admissions are subject to the approval of Saurashtra University, Rajkot




Online Feedback of Lecturers by students


