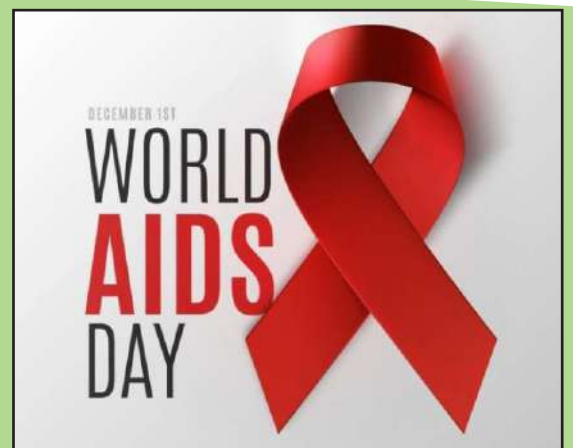
Guest lecture by Swami Avyayanandaji
