

On July 27, 2015, at the age of 83, Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam passed away after a massive cardiac arrest while delivering a lecture to the students of the Indian Institute of Management in the Meghalaya state capital Shillong, India. Dr. Kalam, fondly called the 'People's President' and the 'Missile Man of India' was one of the most celebrated scientists of this century. As well as receiving numerous awards and honorary doctorates from over 30 universities, he was honoured with the 'Padma

Bhushan', 'Padma Vibhushan', and the 'Bharat Ratna', the highest civilian award of India.

The Indian government declared a seven-day state mourning as a tribute to our former president and top scientist. The staff and students of the college paid homage to the 'Missile Man of India' by lighting candles in the college on 29th July, 2015. Students shared their views about Dr. Kalam as being a person who sowed the seeds of change into young minds and who envisaged a revolutionized nation and a livable planet.






