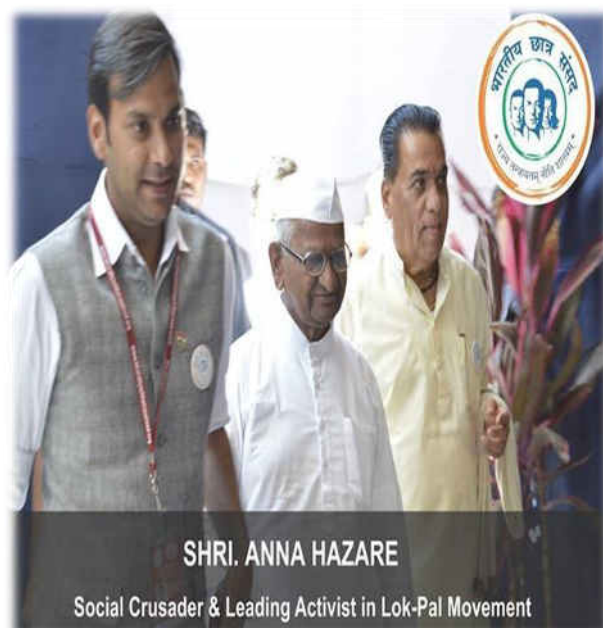
Study in Canada

Spot Photography Competition

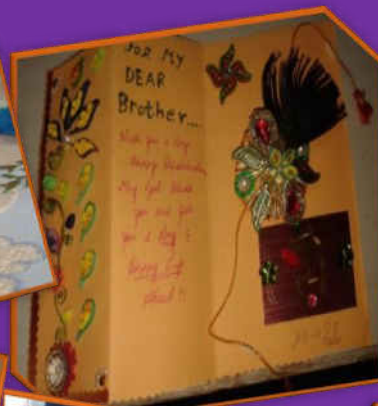

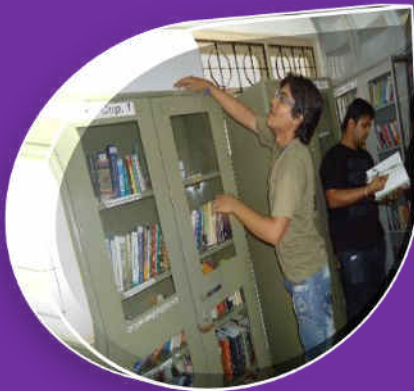
News Broadcasting

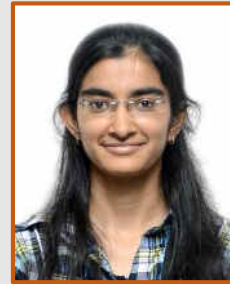
